Trivia starts at 6:30 until approximately 8:30

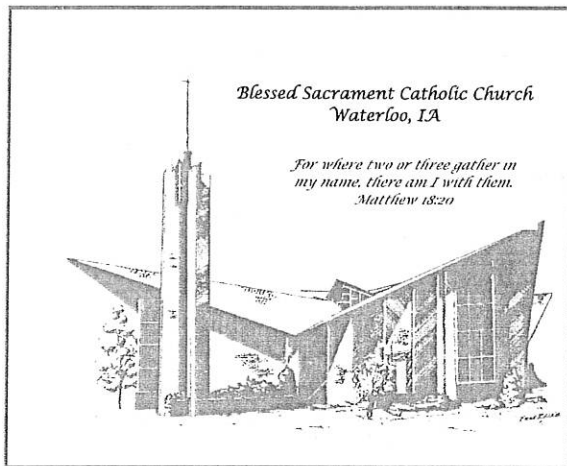
Please bring a snack to share and your own drinks

Discipleship Through Social Justice-April 28-30, 2017 at Prairiewoods Franciscan Spirituality Center, Hiawatha.
